



BASIC NOTES to the MM2H Programme

There are **2** stages to Applying for the Malaysia My Second Home programme

Stage:

- 1.** Submission Qualifications and documents required *before* approval (*For SUBMISSION*) to *get* approval. Documents required vary from documents after approval.

For example you need to show minimum 3 month bank statement balances of RM350, 000 per month (above 50 years) BUT need to place only RM150,000 in fixed deposits upon approval.

*(For below 50 years) need to show RM500,000 but FD required **after** approval is RM300,000)*

- 2.** Conditions to fulfill *after* approval (UPON APPROVAL)

There are 2 categories of applicants:

Category:

- 1.** Below 50 years of age
- 2.** 50 years old and above



FOR SUBMISSION Documents required

1) Letter of Application (Cover Letter)

- Personal background including indicate your intention to join the Malaysia My Second Home Programme (MM2H)- With whom you wish to come (single or with family) A simple letter will do address to Malaysia My Second Home Centre

- Briefly explain how you will support your stay in Malaysia (financial capabilities). Proof of a **minimum Monthly income of RM10,000 (excluding rental income or bank interests) is required.**

Letter stating that from company can suffice

2) Six (6) passport-sized **photographs** of each applicant

3) A certified copy of **Passport** / travel document (all pages). **If new passport, he/she must attach copies of previous passport. If old passport must get** confirmations from home country authorities stating so.

NEW Passport means less than 1 year old

4) A certified copy of **Marriage Certificate** (if accompanied by spouse) All in English

5) A certified copy (s) of **birth certificate** (if accompanied by non-Married Children below 21) All in English

6) **Resume with 10 years** of working experience including academic qualifications, skills, working experience Resume required

7) Certified copy of latest **3 months bank statements** /other related financial document to indicate the financial capability to support stay in Malaysia. Proof of Monthly Income of at least RM10,000 per month.

Bank Statements from any number of banks can be from any bank anywhere

8) **Authorization letter** from applicant to Malaysia My Second Home Centre to verify the financial documents with the relevant financial institutions Will supply

9) **Letter of Good Conduct** (All the applicant has to do is to request it from their Embassies / Ministry of Foreign Affairs or Police Department for it. The Letter of Good Conduct should state whether the applicant has any previous criminal record and also whether there is any case pending against him/her) Must get from police or authority

10) **Self declaration** on your/ dependants health conditions Will supply format

If **Below 50 years old**, **Minimum** Month End-Bank Balance of RM500,000 per month (can be from more than one bank account). Require 3 Months Bank statements ((Preferably furnish us original copies of bank statements)

If **50 years and Above**, **Minimum** Bank Month-End Balances of RM350,000 per month (can be from more than one bank account). Require 3 Months bank Statements ((Preferably furnish us original copies of bank statements)

All copies of documents must be attested as "True and Correct" of Original Documents by notary public, embassy/high commission. All documents must be in English or translated by qualified translator into English.



UPON APPROVAL (with conditions)

In order to get the Visa on to the passport/s applicant must comply with following:

i) Aged BELOW 50 years old

- Open a fixed deposit account of RM300,000 in a Malaysian Bank Account
- **After a period of one year**, the participant can withdraw up to RM150,000 for **approved expenses** relating to house purchase, education for children, car purchase in Malaysia and medical purposes.
- Must maintain a minimum balance of RM150,000 from second year onwards and throughout stay in Malaysia under this programme

ii) Aged 50 years and ABOVE

- Can either : Government Approved or Government Pension Fund
OR - Open a fixed deposit account of RM150,000 ;
 - After a period of one year, participant who fulfill the fixed deposit criteria can withdraw up to RM50,000 for approved expenses relating to house purchase, car purchase, education for children in Malaysia and medical purposes.
 - Participant must maintain a minimum balance of RM100,000 from the second year onwards and throughout stay in Malaysia under this programme.
- Participant needs to sign the Consent Form as Customer's Declaration to authorise the Bank to confirm the existence of the FD when required by the relevant Government Authorities.

Medical Report

All applicants and their dependents (spouse and children) are required to submit a medical report from any private hospital / registered clinic in Malaysia. Do in Malaysia

Medical Insurance

Approved participants and dependents (spouse and children) must possess a valid medical insurance policy, which is applicable in Malaysia.

Immigration Fees: Per Person per year RM90

Multiple entry passes: RM30 per person per year (depending on citizenship)

Journey performed Visa (If required) RM520 per person/onetime.

Allowances

Qualified MM2H participants aged 50 and above with specialised skills and expertise that are required in the critical sectors of the economy, are allowed to work not more than 20 hours per week.

MM2H participants are allowed to invest and actively participate in business, subject to existing Government policies, regulations and guidelines which are in force for the relevant sectors.

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INCENTIVES

Can apply for a Domestic Maid even from Home Country if they wish

Can apply to Purchase a locally assembled car Tax free which can save up to 35% of the Normal Price, or import their own car from home country

Below 50 years Old

Approved participants who have purchased and own property which were bought at RM1 million and above in Malaysia may comply with the basic fixed deposit requirement of RM 100,000 on condition that the property has been fully paid and ownership documents such as grant and land title have already been issued. This amount may not be withdrawn until the participant decides to terminate his participation in MM2H programme.

50 years and above

Approved participants who have purchased and owned property which were bought at RM1 million and above in Malaysia may comply with the basic fixed deposit requirement of RM 100,000, on condition that the property has been fully paid and ownership documents such as grant and land title have already been issued. This amount may not be withdrawn until the participant decides to terminate his participation in MM2H programme

The Malaysia My Second Home Programme (MM2H) is promoted by the Government of Malaysia to allow foreigners who fulfill certain criteria, to stay in Malaysia for as long as possible on a multiple-entry social visit pass. The Social Visit Pass is initially for a period of ten (10) years, and is renewable.

ELIGIBILITY

It is open to citizens of countries recognised by Malaysia, regardless of race, religion, gender or age. The programme allows applicants to bring with them their spouses, parents and children. Foreign spouses of Malaysians and expatriates who wish to retire in Malaysia after expiry of their Employment Passes are also eligible to apply to stay in Malaysia on this programme.

Applicants are allowed to bring their spouses, unmarried children below the age of 21 and parents above the age of 60 as dependants.

FULL GOVERNMENT SUPPORT

This programme is initiated, organised and launched by the Malaysian Government and is thus one that the Government will continuously seek to improve, to ensure its success.

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
